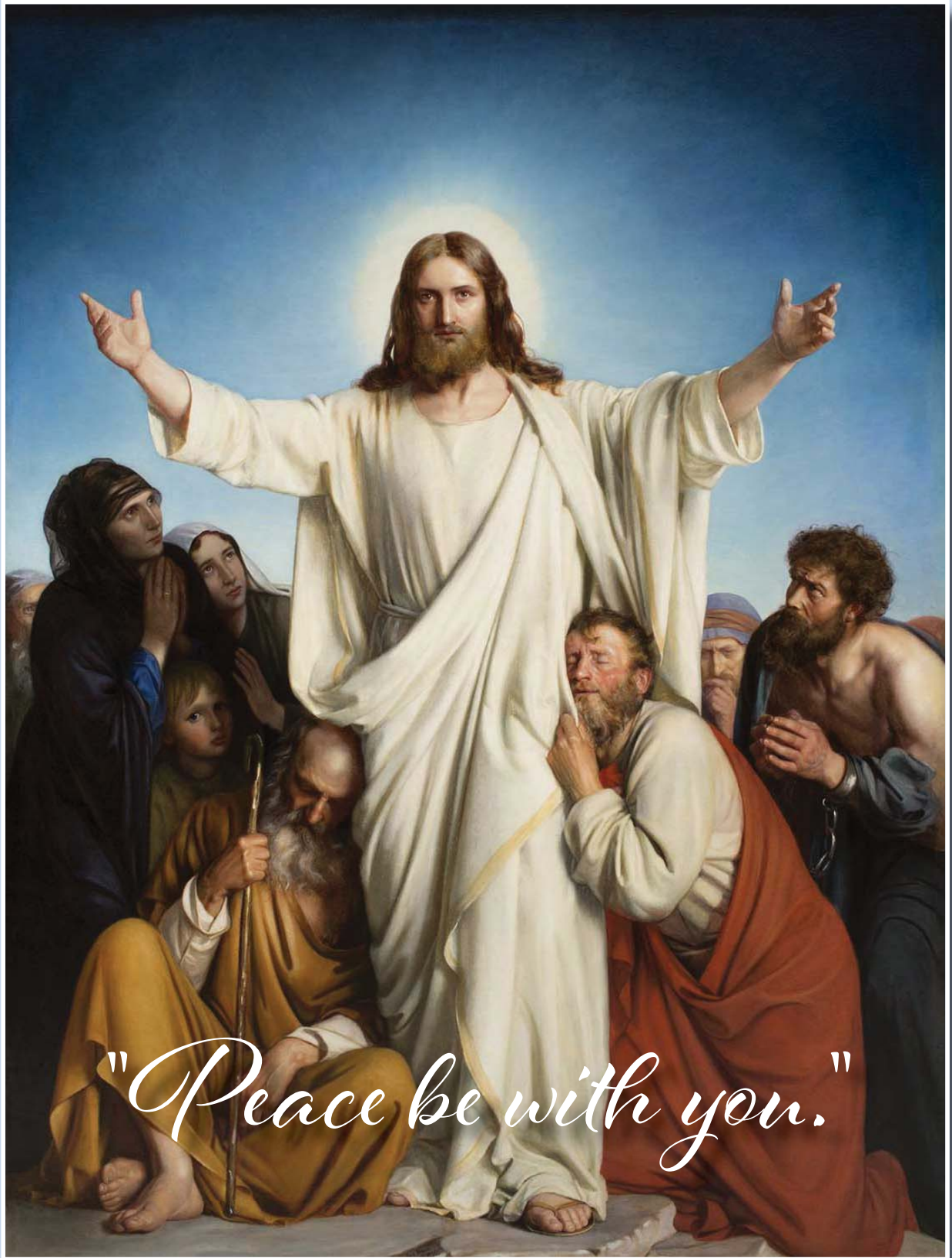

THE FAMILY: THE FOUNDATION OF SOCIETY

What does it mean to marry someone?

To marry someone means to give oneself completely to that person: husband and wife should live together and be there for each other, with their whole physical and mental constitution.

Marriage embraces all areas of life.

It is in marriage, where sexual union has its just place, that the love of a man and a woman becomes fruitful.

After all, marriage is fundamentally designed to be enlarged into a family with children.

Even in marriages in which children are not possible, the union of a man and a woman is the kind of union through which children are conceived.

Considering all these aspects, it is not possible to talk about "homosexual marriage".

Even the expression "equality in marriage" is ambiguous.

Both husband and wife have equal dignity as human persons.



But their different and complementary roles are rooted in their very being—even to the level of their chromosomes.

What significance does marriage have for the family?

Marriage is the foundation of the family.

For Christians, it is a sacrament and, therefore, a great sign from God of salvation.

Even before that, however, it is the Church's conviction and experience that marriage is the optimal basis for a common life of man, woman, and children.

Only in marriage is unconditional

reliability guaranteed, a reliability not subject to time or other restrictions.

Thus it offers all family members the humanly appropriate protection and room for development they need.

How is one to evaluate other forms of living together?

The Church quite clearly regards marriage and family as the vocation which corresponds to the deepest longings of man and woman.

In this she takes in the current debate a firm stance against the increasing breakdown in the close connection between sexuality and interpersonal ties, between emotion and responsibility, sexuality and children, partnership and family.

Nevertheless, the Church also reaches out with charity to those who live in other ways, and looks for opportunities to make of these forms a path of conversion towards the fullness of the vocation of marriage.

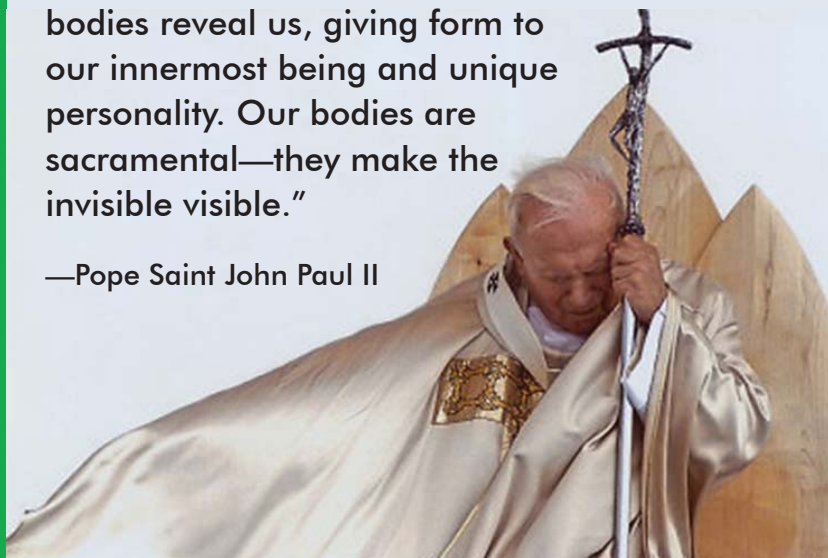

Our Lady of Perpetual Help's quarterly Memorial Mass will be on **Saturday, April 28 at 5PM.**

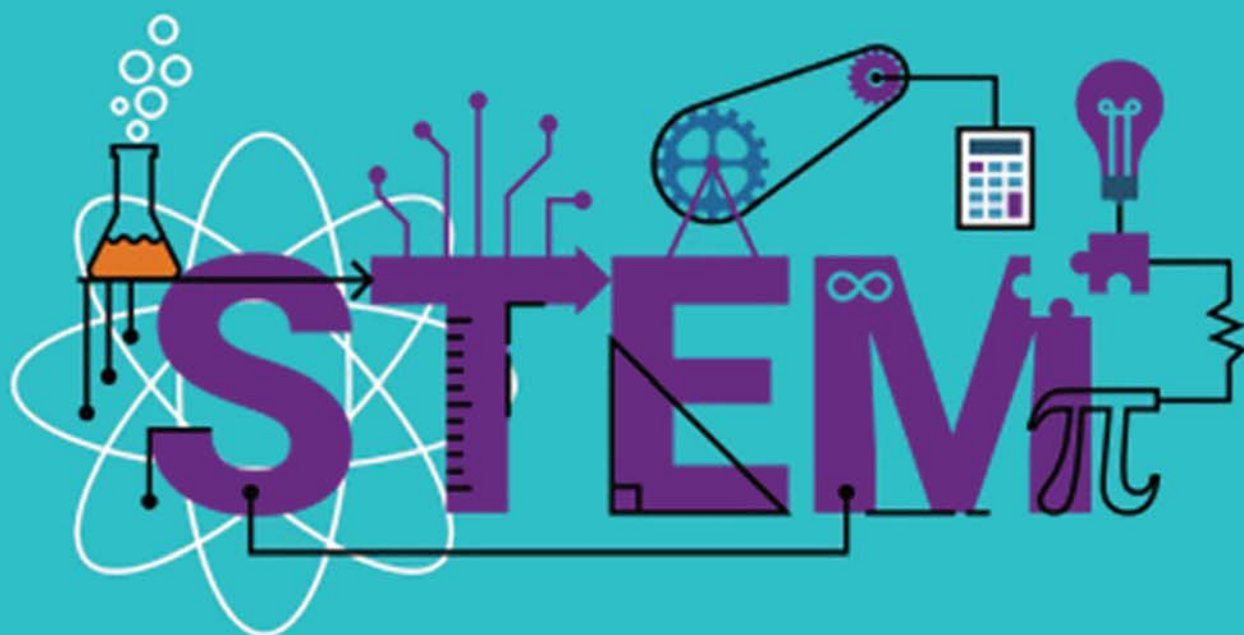
